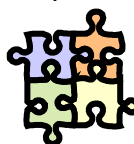
### Training Day

## Absences



Please remember that on the first day of an absence from school we need a phone call to the school office before 9.30am to let us know that your child is poorly. On return to school please could you send a note into the school office giving the details of the absence for our records.

In the case of sickness and diarrhoea we ask that according to NHS guidelines your child does not return to school until 48 hours after the last occurrence of illness to prevent the spread of bugs to other children.
